The Happy Lark Art Studio

The Happy Lark Art Studio was founded by owner Kristal Petruzzi in September of 2015. Petruzzi specializes in teaching drawing and painting classes for both children and adults, and offers a wide variety of art supplies, jewelry, and clothing in her studio store. Classes vary each month, but ongoing classes include: weekly community paint nights, kids' paint nights, intuitive painting classes, and comic style drawing classes. Kids' art classes are offered weekly after school, and adult classes are given during both AM and PM sessions. Assemblage/sculpture classes are offered most months. Private parties are scheduled by appointment.

Mission: To bring Art to the small community of Crestview, Florida.

"We want to bring recognition to the value of Art," said Petruzzi. "People do not insist on Art being in schools here. There is no money in public schools for Art supplies. We wanted to build a stronghold here, to have a consistency with a presence. We hope it will be a place for other artists

to come and build an Art community." (K. Petruzzi, personal communication, March 31, 2016)

Challenges: The Happy Lark Art Studio is located in a small city, Crestview, Florida, which does not have any galleries or museums to date. Most artists in the community are beginning or closet artists, with no visible presence of established artists. There is currently no strong value nor emphasis on Art in this town.

Future plans: The Happy Lark Art Studio staff wish to educate young people and beginning artists. It is their hope that a love of Art will spread throughout the community, and that practicing Art will no longer be an oddity, but accepted.

"We would love an artist's market," said Petruzzi. "People in the community have to think Art is valuable and accepted in

order for it to be so. We would like to open minds up to Art, and show that it is beneficial and attainable, and accessible to everyone. Not just a chosen, privileged few." (K. Petruzzi, personal communication, March 31, 2016)
